God has a mission – and calls us to join in!

Week 3: God creates: a fallen world



### Review:

Last week we looked at how God creates a good world, how human beings are the pinnacle of God's creation and set apart by God to have care for it. It is an idyllic picture but as we know from today's reading (Gen 3) and from our own experience of life that this was all about to change!



### Discuss:

- 1. The causes of the fall** (how sin enters the world)  
The first cause of sin is an act of disobedience but this comes about through deception and wrong desire.  
How does Satan use deception to undermine God's word & character?(1-6)  
Do you experience people believing God is a killjoy & how do you respond?  
Reflect on what it was Eve desired (verse 6)?  
The knowledge of good and evil is more than simply knowing right from wrong it is deciding on what is right or wrong! How do you respond to this statement?
- 2. The consequences of the fall** (the impact that sin has on the world)  
In what ways are shame, fear and blame evident in our world today?
- 3. The seeker of the fallen**  
Look at the questions God asks in 9-11. What is God's purpose in asking them?  
How does God provide for Adam & Eve's shame? v21  
What parallels do you see in how God provides for our shame? Read Eph 5:1-13
